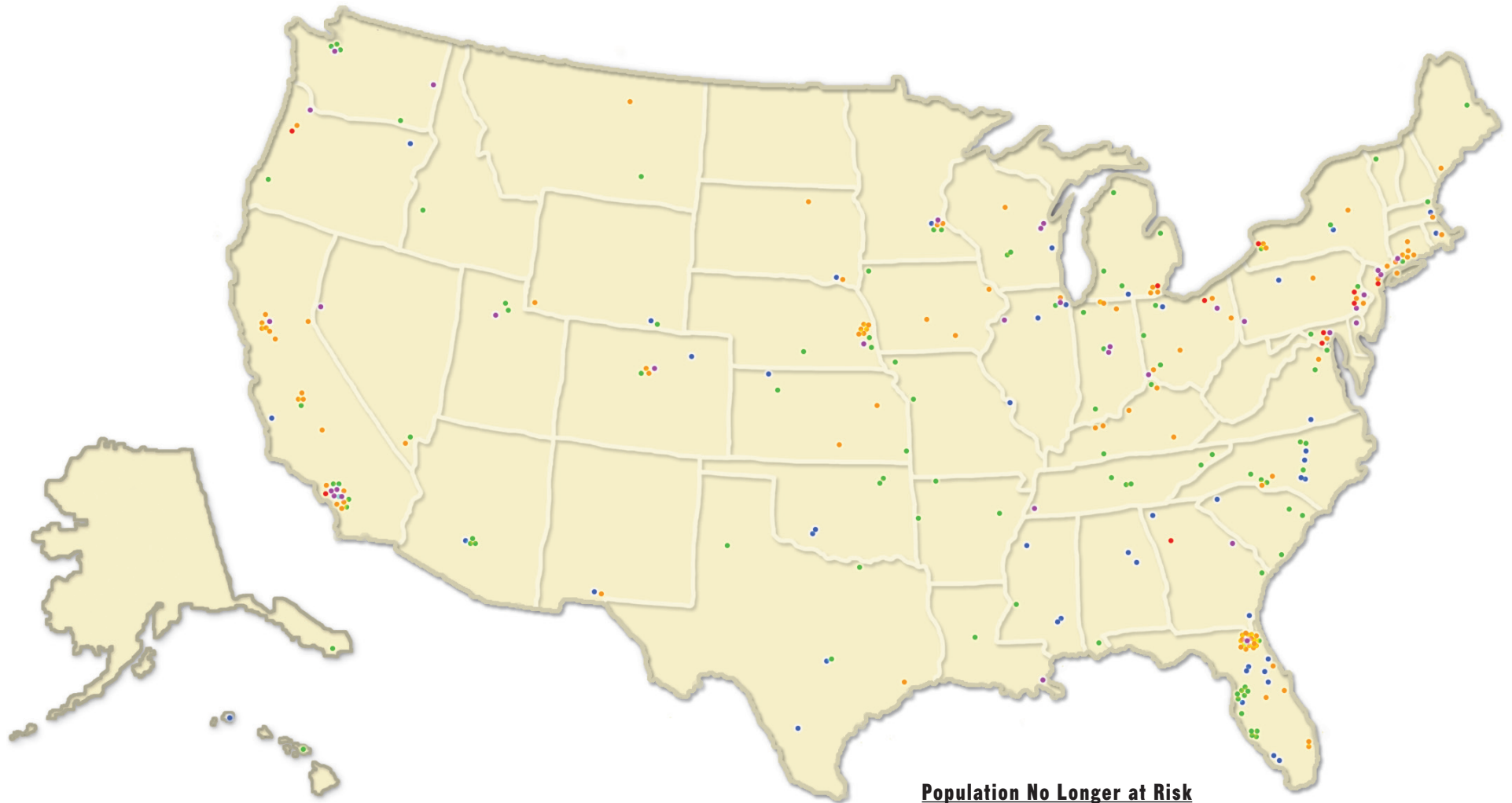


Chemical Facilities That Have Removed the Risk of a Toxic Gas Release

A survey by the Center for American Progress identified 284 facilities that have converted to safer chemicals or processes, or in a few cases moved to less populated areas. This map shows their locations. No terrorist attack or accident can set off a catastrophic toxic gas release at one of these facilities. Dots are color coded to indicate the number of people in surrounding communities that are no longer at risk because of facility conversions. Facilities reported these population figures to the Environmental Protection Agency.
